



'Let's Learn'

We have been learning about:

06.10.17

This week we have also been exploring the text "What the Ladybird Heard", finding rhyming words and thinking about how we can work together as a team. The children have enjoyed making lists and maps based on the story, using a range of skills and considering the wider world around them.

In our reading we have been working hard to learn at sight and at speed the words: **he, me, we, she, my**. We became mechanics and took them apart, to find the individual phonemes (sounds) i.e. c-a-t. Then, we put them back together again! We also worked hard to learn to form the letter shapes so we could write these words down in our special writing books. Please continue to support your child in learning all 21 words to date and the next set, at sight and at speed.

In our work period, we have been thinking lots about number this week. Children have been working to consolidate their knowledge of numbers and amounts within 10, adding amounts within 10 and writing and recording these amounts. We have also extended our thinking to include numbers to 20 and beyond. Goodness we are working hard! We have also begun to think about maps and map making. We will use this knowledge to begin to make maps of the world.
