We have been learning about:

22.9.17

This week we have been thinking about our personal qualities, what we are good at and how to be a good friend. In our learning we explored different emotions we may feel and why we might feel that way. We thought about the words: **good, happy, naughty, sad, cross, frightened, excited, unkind**. Please take some time to continue to reinforce these concepts with your child at home this weekend.

We have also been exploring the text "The Giant Jam Sandwich" and how the village of Itchingdown solved their wasp problem! We will be making bread next week.

In our reading we have been working hard to learn at sight and at speed the words: **am, a, in, can, get, big**. We became mechanics and took them apart, to find the individual phonemes (sounds) i.e. c-a-t. Then, we put them back together again! We also worked hard to learn to form the letter shapes so we could write these words down in our special writing books. Please continue to support your child in learning all 11 words to date and the next set, at sight and at speed.

In our work period, all of our children continue to show focus in their learning and exploration. This week we began to look at insects, which proved very popular. Our range of materials continues to grow and we are very excited to see how your children continue to progress. Please talk to your child about what they chose to work with this week.
