This week we have been working busily to rehearse our Nativity, which we are very excited to show you all next week! Thank you to you all for bringing in your wonderful costumes. In addition, we have been exploring the story of "Stone Soup", which we have learned by heart. Please ask your child to tell the story and show you their actions. In our phonics we continued to look at complex vowel diagraphs by exploring the /ay/ family. We looked at "a, the short a" (as in acorn), "ay may I play" (as in day and play), "ai snail in the rain" (as rail and train) and "a-e the split a-e" (as in cake). We also worked with our /ee/ sounds (as previous)

Please support your child by finding these phonemes in words as you read at home.

Your children are making huge progress with their reading. This is very important as the acceleration they make now in their reading skills will impact their writing during the Spring term.

Please do continue to support them by reading with them every day and by sending their reading book into school, so that we can read together every day too.
