In our phonics we continued to look at complex vowel digraphs by exploring the /o/ family. We looked at "o, the short o" (as in go), "ow blow the snow" (as in snow and show), "oa goat in a boat" (as toad and road) and "o-e the split o-e" (as in poke). We also continued to work with our /ai/ and /ee/ sounds in all their forms (as previous).

Please support your child by finding these phonemes in words as you read at home.

All our children have been issued with an additional library book (chosen by them) to help support and extend their reading exposure. This book should be read through each week and then returned to school on Friday's so that it can be changed for another.

Please continue to read every day with your child at home, exploring their guided reading book. Can I also request that you record reading in their reading diary, so that we can support your child's progress better in school.
