Welcome back! We hope you all had a wonderful half term together.

This week our children returned ready and excited to learn! We began our red hot learning challenges and everyone is doing so well. We are especially proud of the wonderful writing being completed. We read the story of "Bad Jelly the Witch" and began to think about what we might say to her as a result of her actions. Try to spend time talking to your child about the story and explore the moral of 'doing the right thing and being kind'.

In our reading we have been continuing to practise our sight words and this week we began to spell them and write them. We will continue to practise writing them at speed now, as this will help us to become strong, independent writers. Please continue to practise all 45 sight words at home until your child can read them all. We are looking forward to giving out our first awards.

In our work period, we have been thinking lots about number this week. Children have been working to consolidate their knowledge of numbers and amounts within 20, adding amounts within 10 and writing and recording these amounts in different ways. We have also extended our thinking to include numbers to 50 and begun working with the 100 square. When supporting your child's counting to 20, explore how teen numbers are made up of 10 + another number (i.e. $10 + 1 = 11$). This will help to prepare them for their ongoing number bond work.
