



'Let's Learn'

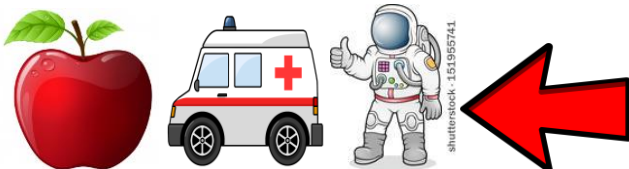


We have been learning about:
