This week we have continued to think about our dreams and aspirations. The children have been thinking about what job they might like to do when they grow up and we have spent time exploring different roles. We even had a special visit from PC Smith! This information will form the basis of our work on emergency calls.

In our phonics we continued to look at complex vowel diagraphs, exploring familial links and we began to look at the new sounds /oi/ using the rhyme "oi spoil the boy", /ur/ using "ur purse for a nurse" and /ow/, using "ow brown cow".
