We have been learning about:

This week we have continued to explore the text "Rosie's Hat", finding rhyming words and thinking about why the author might have chosen to use certain words. Our wow word this week was 'fearless'. We wrote a sentence about why we thought Rosie was fearless. The children have also enjoyed creating collages based on geometric artists and we made our first maps of the world, labelling North America and Europe.

Please talk to your child about any of their learning this week and their favourite elements.

In our reading we have been working hard to learn at sight and at speed the words: **he, me, we, she, my**. We became mechanics and took them apart, to find the individual phonemes (sounds) i.e. w-e and talked about why we cannot segment 'my'. We also worked hard to learn to form the letter shapes so we could write these words down in our special writing books. Please continue to support your child in learning all 21 words to date and the next set, at sight and at speed.

In our work period, we have been thinking lots about number this week. Children have been working to consolidate their knowledge of numbers and amounts within 10 and 20, and thinking about more and less within the sequence. Goodness we are working hard! We have continued to think carefully about seasonal change and observed leaves we had collected carefully, as part of our science.
