We have been learning about:

This week we have continued to think about our rights and how we might be a good friend to others. As part of our wider learning, we thought about the colour spectrum and how we can impact colours by mixing them. We designed our own rainbows with water colours. We have also continued to read our Treasured Text "Rosie's Hat" and extended our vocabulary with the word 'shriek'.

Please take time to continue to talk to your child about these concepts at home over the weekend.

In our reading we have been working hard to learn at sight and at speed the words: **on, and, up, at, is, of**. We became mechanics and took them apart, to find the individual phonemes (sounds) i.e. c-a-t. Then, we put them back together again! We also worked hard to learn to form the letter shapes so we could write these words down in our special writing books. Please continue to support your child in learning all 16 words to date and the next set, at sight and at speed.

In our work period, all of our children continue to show focus in their learning and exploration. This week we began to think more about the world around us. We revised the continents North America and Europe, focusing on Ancient Greece. We looked at some beautiful pottery urns and jugs, before exploring some from our own classroom. We will be making some of our own with clay in the coming weeks.
