## **EDUCATIONAL VISIT TO ASH END FARM, TAMWORTH**

It is proposed to arrange a visit for Nursery and Reception Children to Ash End Farm on **Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> May**, leaving school at 9.15am. The children will be arriving back by the end of the normal school day. Please return the attached parental consent form by Friday 10<sup>th</sup> May to enable the visit arrangements to be completed and confirmed.

As this visit takes place wholly in school time it is necessary to ask for a voluntary contribution of £12.50 per pupil to cover entrance and transport costs. There is no obligation to contribute and no pupil will be omitted from the visit because they do not pay in full. However, the visit cannot go ahead if the school does not receive sufficient parental contributions. Payment may be made with cash, cheque (made payable to St. Leonard's Primary School) or via your ParentPay account.

We will travel to and from Ash End Farm by coach. If your child is prone to travel sickness, please ensure they have taken the appropriate medication prior to the journey, and if necessary send a tablet in a named envelope with instructions for use, the return journey. Your child will be expected to be responsible enough to wear the seatbelt provided until informed it may be released.

There is a small play park at the farm which, if we have time, the children can use under our supervision. Please let one of the teachers know if you do not wish your child to use the play park.

Pupils attending this visit will need to have a record of good behaviour and demonstrate that they can obey safety and other rules.

Your child will need a packed lunch and drink. Please put this in a named carrier bag that can be thrown away after lunch. Reception children should wear school uniform. All children should wear a coat and sensible shoes.

All bona fide educational visits by Staffordshire schools are covered by the County Council's public liability insurance, as are all in-school activities. The visit is considered to have only normal everyday risks and no further insurance has been provided.
