We have been learning about:

This week we have been thinking about the weather! We explored 'thunder' and began to think about what it is and how it is caused. We also began to think about what clothes we might need for certain types of weather and next week we will continue to explore why certain materials are better or worse, for specific weather types. ***Over the weekend, can you think about clothes you have at home and the materials they are made from?*** We watched the weather carefully this week and used our school weather station to track weather changes. We have made our own recordings of the weather each day. ***Perhaps you can make a rain gauge together at home, to measure how much rain there is over the coming week? Perhaps send in a picture for us to share?***

In our reading we have been working hard to learn at sight and at speed the words: **am, a, in, can, get, big**. We became mechanics and took them apart, to find the individual phonemes (sounds) i.e. c-a-t. Then, we put them back together again! We also worked hard to learn to form the letter shapes so we could write these words down in our special writing books. Please continue to support your child in learning all words to date and the next set, at sight and at speed.
