

'Let's Learn'

We have been learning about:

This week we have continued to think carefully about seasonal change. What does this mean and how do we know that we are moving into another 'weather era'? The children shared their own thoughts and experiences, before representing what they felt autumn is, themselves. Over the coming weeks we will spend time in our own garden and the conservation area observing the changes occurring carefully. Please ensure your child has wellies and a warm outdoor coat in school. While you are at home, perhaps you could also observe change in your own locality. What do you notice that tells you autumn in coming?

In our reading we have been working hard to learn at sight and at speed the words: he, me, we, she, my. We became mechanics and took them apart, to find the individual phonemes (sounds) i.e. c-a-t. Then, we put them back together again! We also worked hard to learn to form the letter shapes so we could write these words down in our special writing books.
